Program Participation > Benefit Record Number	Previously this value could be set to values other than 0 either manually or by the system. Employees with benefits records other than 0 were not having all their benefits deducted during the payroll process.

Personal Information – Updating Dummy SSN Navigator > Workforce Administration > Personal Information > Biographical > Modify a Person	Currently, when a 'Dummy Social Security Number (SSN)' is updated with the correct SSN, the record has been saved, and the practitioner goes back into Personal Data to review, the 'Dummy SSN' box is checked again. The new code will allow Shared Service C/HR Practitioner to uncheck the box, open the National ID field for update, and successfully save the correct SSN and ensure the 'Dummy SSN' box is no longer checked. Reminder : Institutions should coordinate with SSC to ensure that all other business processes are followed related to update/correction of a Social Security Number.
