



Technical Release Notes Academic Release 1.14

MODIFICATIONS:

Academic Release 1.14 includes the following:

- Campus ETL and table modifications for the following columns:
 - SECTION_INSTRUCTION_TYPE
 - SESSION_INSTRUCTION_TYPE_CODE
- Data Element Dictionary updates for the following data elements:
 - Section Instruction Type Code (SEC008)
 - Session Instruction Type Code (SES006)

IMPACT: Implementation is mandatory.

PREREQUISITES: The prerequisite for the Academic Release 1.14 is:

- Data Collection ETL (ZADMETL) 1.3

MANAGED SERVICES TECHNICAL NOTE: If you are a hosted institution in production, we will contact the helpdesk to have a ticket opened, on your behalf, to request the software to be applied to your Pre-Production and Production environments. We will copy you on the communication to our helpdesk.

TECHNICAL INSTRUCTIONS: CAMPUS_ODS_ADM_ETL_INSTALL.sql - This script is required for all institutions and should be run as USGQUEST on the Banner database. It contains the tables, views and selection criteria for the Academic Data Collection.

After downloading the file CAMPUS_ODS_ADM_ETL_INSTALL.sql, you may run the following checksum command to validate the file is the same as the one located in the directory above:

1. Download the package (CAMPUS_ODS_ADM_ETL_INSTALL.sql) file to a local server.
2. Run the following command, to make sure the checksum info is the same as ITS posted with the package: \$ md5sum CAMPUS_ODS_ADM_ETL_INSTALL.sql
3. Verify the checksum info you get from the above command. It should be the same as below:

113e8c57f142696be3696b04198c4cc1 CAMPUS_ODS_ADM_ETL_INSTALL.sql

BEST PRACTICE: You are strongly urged to apply this upgrade to your test environment before applying it to production. Institutions should comprehensively test using local business processes to ensure that the functionality meets regulatory requirements.
