


### USG Fall Headcount and FTE


#### Percent Change from Previous Year, Enrollment by Sector







### Undergraduate vs. Graduate Enrollment






### **Dual Enrollment**






# Total System Headcount with and without Dual Enrollment






# Beginning Freshman Enrollment






### Undergrad Headcount by Student Level





# Enrollment by Race/Ethnicity






### Percent of Enrollment that is Female






## Percent In-State by Sector







#### Non-Residents with Tuition Waivers








### Undergraduate Enrollment in Online Courses\*






#### Graduate Enrollment in Online Courses\*
