

Release of Academic Release 1.8

PURPOSE: To release Academic Release 1.8, which includes the following:

- High Impact Practice Course Section Attributes (Modification)
- International Virtual Exchange Course Section Attribute (New)
- Field of Study Category Report Filters (Modification)
- Byte to Character Data Format (Modification)

This collection will open on November 25, 2020.

SOURCE: Information Technology Services (ITS)

PREREQUISITE: The prerequisite for the Academic Release 1.8 is Data Collection ETL (ZADMETL) 1.3.

IMPACT: Implementation of the Academic Release 1.8 is mandatory.

MANAGED SERVICES TECHNICAL NOTE: No action is required for ITS Managed Services customers. Hosted Institutions will be contacted by ITS to schedule the installation of this release.

TECHNICAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILE VALIDATION (CAMPUS_ODS_ADM_ETL_INSTALL.sql):

After downloading the file (CAMPUS_ODS_ADM_ETL_INSTALL.sql), you may run the following checksum command to validate the file is the same as the one located in the directory above:

- 1. Download the package (CAMPUS_ODS_ADM_ETL_INSTALL.sql) file to a local server.
- Run the following command, replacing to make sure the checksum info is the same as it was when ITS posted the package: \$md5sum CAMPUS_ODS_ADM_ETL_INSTALL.sql
- 3. Verify the checksum info you get from the above command. It should be the same as below:

1182ca035c7da245f95923a7c711ffbdCAMPUS ODS ADM ETL INSTALL.sql
