

Financial Aid Data Collection (FADC) 19/20 Aid Year

Information Technology Services (ITS) announces that the Financial Aid Data Collection for the 19/20 Aid Year will open on October 6, 2020.

Changes in this collection include the following:

- Fund Code Maximum Award Amounts (modified)
- Discontinue collection of the Perkins Loan (modified)
- Modifications to the Financial Aid Data Element Dictionary (DED)
- ODI error notification for tables submitted without data (new)
- Disable the APEX Load button (modified)

NOTE: All institutions will be required to perform an initial extraction by **October 13, 2020**. Please ensure you can log on to the <u>Apex extraction application</u> prior to October 6th to confirm credentials have not expired. If you receive an invalid account or password error, please contact the ITS Helpdesk at 706-583-2001 for assistance. Extractions cannot begin until the collection opens.


IMPACT: No changes were made to the to the Banner components of the FADC 19/20 collection. No new software is needed.

PREREQUISITE: Institutions must run the Banner FISAP Process (RORFS20) prior to extracting for the 19/20 collection.
