

Release of Facilities Inventory Release 1.2

PURPOSE: To release Facilities Inventory Release 1.2, which includes the following:

 Remove Classification of Instructional Programs (CIP) Codes from the Facilities Inventory Data Collection (modification)

This collection will open on September 4, 2020.

SOURCE: Information Technology Services (ITS)

PREREQUISITE: The prerequisite for the Facilities Inventory Release 1.2 is Data Collection ETL (ZADMETL) 1.3.

IMPACT: Implementation of the Facilities Inventory Release 1.2 is mandatory.

MANAGED SERVICES NOTE: This release is required for a strategic USG initiative. Please contact ITS as soon as possible to confirm installation next week with ITS technical services staff.

TECHNICAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILE VALIDATION (CAMPUS_ODS_FIDM_ETL_INSTALL.sql):

After downloading the file (CAMPUS_ODS_FIDM_ETL_INSTALL.sql), you may run the following checksum command to validate the file is the same as the one located in the directory above:

- 1. Download the package (CAMPUS_ODS_FIDM_ETL_INSTALL.sql) file to a local server.
- Run the following command, replacing to make sure the checksum info is the same as it was when ITS posted the package: \$md5sum CAMPUS_ODS_FIDM_ETL_INSTALL.sql
- 3. Verify the checksum info you get from the above command. It should be the same as below:

27167082d5c8f62b33b6b749b1f6cf72 CAMPUS_ODS_FIDM_ETL_INSTALL.sql
