 - Does not replace the impact of study abroad or international students, should be considered a complement or addition
- USG International Education Grant
 - Awarded three of the grants all in IVE
 - o Georgia College, West Georgia, and Georgia Gwinnett College
- International Activities report available under the "about us" tab. To be used as benchmarking data to make the case for support on your home campus
- English language proficiency review will be delayed for one year.

Liz Havey, Georgia College, provided a summary of the International Virtual Exchange on their campus

• Started with the African American Male Initiative and Study Abroad Committee joint workshop in Fall 2019.

- Partnered with exchange university, De Montfort University in Leicester, England
- First conversation in March, 2020 on race, identity and power with the Prince Harry, Megan Markle royal exit. Future conversations begin 9/30/20 and run monthly for the remainder of the academic year.
- GC has expanded on this to create a Border Free Education project connecting faculty, staff, and students to partners world wide for both academic and extracurricular engagement.
