Meeting began at 10am.

- 1. Discussion of website. Minutes needed for 2017-2019.
- 2. Election for Chair-Elect. Only one nomination Tatiana Krivosheev. Vote: 13 yes, 0 no. Dr. Tatianna Krivosheev elected Chair-Elect.
- 3. It was noted that updates to website are communicated to Becky Corvey; Barbara Brown (USG) is webmaster.
- 4. Discussion of AP recommendations for transfers from one USG institution to another USG institution. It appears this is not binding, but is recommended. This is recommended for Physics 1 and 2. It was proposed to insert language "non-binding recommendation."
- AP Physics 1 and 2 score thresholds for course credit discussed. 3 or higher was recommended for PHYS 1111K, 1111, 1111L for Physics 1; 3 or higher for PHYS 1112K, 1112, 1112L for Physics 2.
- 6. AP Physics C score thresholds. Recommendations are 4 or higher for AP Physics C Mechanics for PHYS 2211K, 2211, 2211L, 1211, 1211L; recommendations of 4 or higher for AP Physics C E&M for PHYS 2212K, 2212, 2212L, 1212, 1212L.
- 7. Natural Science CLEP test discussion. No recommendation as there is no system-wide physical science course.
- 8. DSST (formerly DANTES Subject Standardized Tests) test in astronomy discussion. No recommendation as currently no USG institution is currently accepting this test as far as we could tell.
- 9. Discussion of Core redesign. Process expected to restart Fall 2021. RAC will be involved and we should pay attention. Physics and Astronomy could be affected.
