- 1. The minutes of the meeting of November 15, 2008 were approved as distributed.
- 2. Ron Jackson gave an update on the proposed philosophy major at Clayton State. The Provost is currently considering the request. The Committee affirmed the support for this major that was stated at the Nov 15th meeting. The Committee agreed that the Committee Chair would draft a message of support to be sent to the administration at Clayton State.
- 3. The Committee agreed on the following common course numbers:

For 3-hour introduction to philosophy type courses: PHIL 2010

For 3-hour critical thinking type courses: PHIL 2020

For 3-hour introduction to ethics type courses: PHIL 2030

For 3-hour 1000/2000 level philosophy of art type courses: PHIL 2040

For 3-hour 1000/2000 level symbolic logic courses: PHIL 2500

For 2-hour critical thinking type courses: PHIL 1010

Individual departments/programs will need to go through the curriculum change procedures at the institutional level to see that these changes are made.

- 4. The Committee agreed on the following new rules governing Area F.
- 5 9 hours of lower-division Philosophy courses and 9-12 hours of any lower-division courses that add up to a total of 18 hours.

The previous rule required 6 hours in Area F. Georgia State and Georgia Southern will need to make changes to their Area F to come into compliance. All other institutions seem to be in compliance.
