- 3. Summary of Macon meeting for AAC Chairs:
- a. Frank Butler, new Vice Chancellor for Academics, Faculty, and Financial Affairs spoke. His priorities will be service to faculty, and students as well as academic programs.
- b. The Calendar of Events was discussed.
- c. A new recommendation form now exists for committees such as this to use if we care to make recommendations to the BOR offices or staff.
- d. Expect changes in mission and goals under new Chancellor.
- e. Expect emphasis on retention, data standardization, service to students, accountability and program review, streamlining of process for new program review, and improving access of Georgia residents to four-year programs (e.g., use two-year campuses to deliver programs from four-year colleges and universities).
